COURSE DELIVERY MODELS AND DATES

DELIVERY MODELS

Depending upon the course and Cisco's current rules for instructor training, we run the following models of training:

HYBRID IN-PERSON

This is our recommended option.

As 5 days in-person is not enough to read the material, complete the labs and take the exams, we replaced the in-person course with a hybrid model. In this model, the first 5 weeks (minimum) are remote learning of the theory using asynchronous learning, with where available, recorded presentations and access to our NETLAB system. This is then finished by a number of in-person days where the confirmation of theory, labs and final exams are taken (the number of days varies upon course and is detailed with the cost).

FULLY REMOTE

Each course will be a minimum of 9 weeks (and a maximum of 180 days) with a mixture of synchronous and asynchronous teaching with recordings of presentations available, access to our NETLAB system (where available) where the labs can be completed and support via email, WebEx as required. For the final exams, WebEx will be used and a webcam and microphone will be required.

SELF-PACED, PROCTORED EXAM ONLY

For those with experience in this field you can take the self-paced course that is available through https://www.netacad.com/portal/resources/course-resources and then request to take the final exams in a remote proctored environment. This option if successful will not provide the ability to receive a discount voucher. The exams take place in 1 day.

For the final exams, WebEx will be used and a webcam and microphone will be required.

INSTRUCTOR FAST TRACK (IFT)

For those that hold a current industry certification for the relevant course, this option will allow you to become certified as an instructor with only completing the final skills exam.

This course takes place in 1 day.

COURSE DATES

To allow for as much flexibility as possible in allowing instructors to complete any required training, we do not schedule any fixed dates for training courses, but rather provide the courses in an on-demand basis with dates that suit both parties. We may not always be able to provide the dates that you require but we will endeavour to find dates that work for both parties.

COURSE DURATION AND COST

The duration of our courses varies depending on if the courses are **core** Cisco Networking Academy courses that require instructor training or if they are non-core courses where instructor training is optional.

CORE COURSES THAT REQUIRE INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

The core courses that require instructor training are:

- CCNA: Switching, Routing and Wireless Essentials (SRWE)
- CCNA: Enterprise Networking, Security and Automation (ENSA)
- Network Security
- CyberOps Associate
- DevNet Associate
- CCNP Enterprise: Core Networking (ENCOR)
- CCNP Enterprise: Advanced Routing (ENARSI)

COURSE DELIVERY MODELS, DURATION AND COST

For each of the core courses, the following course duration, delivery model and cost is available:

- Hybrid in-person
 - Available for all courses
 - Minimum of 5 weeks remote
 - > Followed by 5 days in-person
 - Cost per instructor is £750
- Fully remote
 - Available for all courses
 - o Minimum of 9 weeks remote
 - Cost per instructor is £750
- Instructor Fast Track (IFT)
 - o Available for all courses
 - Only a single day of exams
 - Cost per instructor is £200
- Self-paced, Proctored Exam only
 - Available ONLY for:
 - CyberOps Associate
 - DevNet Associate
 - Only a single day of exams
 - o Cost per instructor is £200
